Covid Symptoms	Staff, pupils, visitors, contractors, parents	<p>Most common Covid symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fever Dry cough Tiredness Less common symptoms Aches and pains Sore throat Diarrhoea Conjunctivitis Headache Loss of taste and smell Rash on skin Discolouration of fingers and toes <p>A new continuous cough means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or more than three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours.</p>
Next steps if someone displays symptoms		<p>Next steps if someone displays symptoms:</p> <p>Contact 111 either by phone or their website https://111.nhs.uk/covid-19</p> <p>My Child/Adult has COVID-19 symptoms</p> <p>Action needed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Child/Adult shouldn't attend school Child/Adult should get a test Whole household self-isolates while waiting for test result Inform school immediately about test results <p>Back to School:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> when child's/adult's test comes back negative and symptom free for 48 hours <p>My child/adult tests positive for COVID-19 (coronavirus)</p> <p>Action needed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Child/Adult shouldn't attend school Child/Adult self-isolates for at least 10 days from when symptoms* started (or from day of test if no symptoms) Inform school immediately about test results Whole household self-isolates for 14 days from day when symptoms* started (or from day of test if no symptoms) -even if someone tests negative during those 14 days <p>Back to School:</p>
