School Re-Opening – 1st July 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am pleased to inform you that, following discussions with Public Health, Governors and the Local Authority, we will be able to re-open school tomorrow (**Thursday 1st July**). This is because a confirmatory PCR test has been returned as negative, after previously three Lateral Flow Tests showed as positive. This means that our staffing capacity is now increased.

Foundation Stage must still continue to isolate until their return to school on Tuesday 6th July and Year 3 must continue to isolate until their return to school on Friday 9th. These are both due to positive cases which have been confirmed via PCR tests. **All other year groups can return to school from Thursday 1st July. Year 6 no longer need to isolate. Extra curricular clubs and our Breakfast Club and After School Club will resume as normal.**

Please can I remind you all that you must not send your children into school if they have any symptoms, have been in contact with anybody who is symptomatic, have been in contact with somebody who has tested positive, or is awaiting the results of a test.

Please may I also ask you to wear a face covering on school site at any time, when you are dropping off or collecting a child, unless you are exempt (in which case, please ensure staff on the gate are aware of this with either a card or a lanyard).

Thank you for your patience over the last couple of days. This is a really difficult time for all and is hard for everybody to manage; we are all hoping for some government guidance in the next few days regarding how bubble closures will work in September. The actions taken, as always, are to protect the health of the school community at all times.
